

## NOTICE OF PROPOSED CONSOLIDATION OF CONSERVATION DISTRICTS

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN AND PARTICULARLY TO ALL OWNERS OF LAND WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE SAN MIGUEL BASIN AND SHAVANO CONSERVATION DISTRICTS:

The Boards of Supervisors of the San Miguel Basin Conservation District and Shavano Conservation District have filed with the Colorado State Conservation Board for the consolidation of these two districts into a single district, pursuant to the statutory provision, Section 35-70-119, Colorado Revised Statutes. The State Board has notified each of the district boards that it has the authority to proceed with the steps required to hold an election for landowners to vote on the question of consolidation of the two districts into a single district which is proposed to be known as the Shavano Conservation District.

A public hearing will be held on Monday, March 22nd at 6:00 pm via Zoom to determine the necessity and advisability of the consolidation of the two districts.
